Bishop Joseph Warren Walker, III Honoring 25 years of faithful service in ministry



PASTOR: a spiritual overseer;

especially : a clergyman serving a local church or parish

The Call

As a student at Southern University in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, Bishop Joseph W. Walker, III accepted his call to preach. Even before that time, he had sensed in his spirit that he was supposed to do something other than practice law. Bishop Walker remembers the moment when he clearly heard the Lord's voice.

"I heard a voice that simply said, 'NOW'. I didn't quite understand what the voice was telling me to do, but whatever it was, I convinced myself that it couldn't happen at that time because I had already planned out my life. I was going to graduate from Southern and go on to law school. But after I heard that voice, I couldn't focus. I couldn't sleep. I couldn't eat. I ran to the chapel at the Baptist Student Center, fell on my knees, and said, 'God, what?' God said, 'I want you to preach the gospel. I want you to feed my sheep.'" The strong pull of the Spirit caused Bishop Walker to question the path he had planned for himself. So instead of heading to law school, he stepped out on faith and decided to enter seminary. With a letter from his pastor, Dr. Harry Blake, senior pastor of Mount Canaan Missionary Baptist Church in Shreveport, Louisiana, Bishop Walker was accepted into divinity school at Vanderbilt University in Nashville.

"After I arrived in Nashville, I attended a service at Mt. Zion. On my first visit, I sat in the back and observed this congregation of about 120 people. Mrs. Margaret Wilson introduced herself to me and then introduced me to the pastor, the Reverend E. W. Roberson. Once Rev. Roberson learned that I was a minister, he invited me to sit in the pulpit with him. I stayed for a portion of the service, but I decided to leave and visit another church down the street. But after only 15 minutes at the other church, the power of the Holy Spirit compelled me to return to Mt. Zion. As I walked into the sanctuary, Rev. Roberson was finishing his sermon, and I immediately went forward to join the church. At the time, I was the only associate minister, I was a firstyear seminary student, and I was new in the ministry. But I walked alongside the pastor and served to the best of my ability.

Despite his service to Mt. Zion, Bishop Walker had no plans of settling permanently in Nashville. He assumed that after he graduated from Vanderbilt, he would return to Shreveport to assist Dr. Blake in ministry. However, God had other plans for him.

"Pastor Roberson called on me more frequently, and people responded favorably to my preaching and teaching. Even after Pastor Roberson left, members of the congregation wanted me to stay on and become their pastor. So, in April 1992, one month before I graduated from divinity









school, I became pastor of Mt. Zion Baptist Church. Here I was, 24 years old, pastoring my first church. I was in awe!"

As Bishop Walker took on the mantle of pastor, God promised him that his ministry would bless millions of people. Twenty-five years later, Mt. Zion Baptist Church is proof that the promises of God are yes and amen.

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord." (Luke 4:18-19)

The Bible describes a shepherd as one who leads forth a flock from the fold to the place where the sheep are to be pastured. There, the shepherd watches them during the day, taking care that none of the sheep stray. And if some of them elude his watch and wander away from the rest of the flock, he seeks for them diligently until they are found and brought back to the fold. Walker makes time for genuine connections. In addition to greeting members before and after services and participating in the weekly Prayer Call, he gives daily inspiration through Periscope. He is relevant, personal, and even comical as he shares a word of encouragement with the "PeriSquad."

Always on the cutting edge, Bishop Walker's ingenious strategies for ministry reach a multi-

guidance. Whether in person or via Skype, he is devoted to nurturing leaders and sharpening them to become problem-solvers in today's society.

Throughout his life and ministry, Bishop Walker has demonstrated a caliber of leadership well beyond his years. His influence extends beyond the walls of Mt. Zion, reaching audiences worldwide in the private and the public sector as a teacher and a public speaker. He's also a community leader, serving organizations such as New Level Community Development Corporation, Nashville Unites, the American Red Cross, Citizens Bank, Meharry Medical College, and Tennessee State University.

Bishop Walker goes beyond merely talking about societal concerns; he works tirelessly to find creative solutions. In 2016, in his first major initiative as Presiding Bishop of the Full Gospel Baptist Church Fellowship International, he mobilized a nationwide donation of water to the residents of Flint, Michigan, when it was discovered that their drinking water had become contaminated. Bishop Walker and Dr. Steph founded the Drs. Joseph & Stephaine Walker Scholarship Fund. The scholarships are awarded to people to help them to achieve their academic dreams.

A prolific writer, Bishop Walker is the author of nine books. He and Dr. Stephaine co-authored his eighth book, Becoming a Couple of Destiny.

Bishop Walker's genuine love for the people of God is evident in all of his endeavors. We honor him as a man chosen by God to transform lives in this generation.

ideons Trumpet JS Calling US TO ADiv

Gideon blew his trumpet and called Israel to battle and defeat the Midianites (Judges 6:34). His trumpet is now calling us to work for justice. Gideon's Army, a community activist group, works to dismantle the school-toprison pipeline and to encourage juvenile justice reform in Nashville. It released a report in October 2016 entitled "Driving While Black." This report states that between 2011 and 2015, black drivers, despite comprising 27.6 percent of Nashville's driving-age population, were 39.3 percent of all traffic stops--11.7 percent more than the black driving-age population. White drivers, comprising 63.8 percent of the driving-age population, were only 55.5 percent of all traffic stops--8.3 percent less than Nashville's white driving-age population. In 2015-2016, blacks were 2 to 5 times more likely than whites to be stopped multiple times in a year.

The Metro Police Department uses "Flex teams" to flood high crime areas of the city with patrols and to reduce criminal behavior. Misdemeanor traffic violations are used as probable cause to stop vehicles and to determine if further police action is required with the vehicle's occupants above and beyond the moving violations. Such stops, primarily in areas of concentrated minority populations, are reflected in the report's numbers.

On Friday, February 10, 2017, Jocques Clemmons, a 31-year-old African American male and a former convicted felon, ran a stop sign in the Cayce Homes area. He was then approached for the moving violation by Metro Flex officer Joshua Lippert. During the encounter, Clemmons was shot and killed by Officer Lippert, who has a history of disciplinary actions for use of excessive force.

On August 21, 2014, Metro Police Chief Steve Anderson and several top police commanders attended a packed public town hall meeting led by Bishop Joseph W. Walker, III at Mt. Zion Jefferson Street. The meeting was organized to discuss police tactics in dealing with minorities following the Mike Brown shooting in Ferguson, Missouri. Chief Anderson committed to releasing information in such incidents as soon as possible. With the Clemmons shooting, Metro Police have honored that commitment.

Nashville mayor Megan Barry, Chief Anderson, and other officials should be commended for their efforts in addressing such issues by being in constant dialogue with community organizations, putting things in place to mitigate the possibility of officer-involved shootings and subsequent destructive civil unrest from occurring, and providing accountability when those situations occur. District attorney Glenn Funk recently announced that the Tennessee Bureau of Investigations (TBI) will investigate the Clemmons shooting and any future Metro officer-involved shootings. But regardless of

the outcome of the Clemmons investigation, with police disproportionately stopping more minority drivers, the stage remains set for what happened that fateful Friday afternoon to happen again.

Black Lives Matter, NOAH, Nashville Unites, and the NAACP must also be commended for their efforts to initiate dialogue and to trumpet the need for accountability and equitable treatment of minority citizens in encounters with police. Gideon's trumpet calls for us to continue the dialogue and to develop resolutions for this issue. We must work to achieve balance between the need to address Nashville's crime and the civil rights of all its citizens to life, liberty, and justice.

At 32 years old, Dr. Justin Turner is the youngest physician in Mississippi to own his own medical practice, TurnerCare, LLC, where he serves over 3,000 patients in south Jackson, Mississippi. Turner's "approach to medicine involves treating the whole person." He says, "Health can only be optimized if we understand physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual health are interrelated and not separate entities."

Turner's excellence in the medical field has not gone unnoticed. He has received many commendations for his work, including "2015 Top 40 Under 50 by Mississippi Business Journal," "2015 Finalist Best Doctor in Jackson by Jackson Free Press," and "2015 Finalist Best Clinical in Jackson by Jackson Free Press."

A native of Vicksburg, Mississippi, Turner moved to Nashville to pursue his medical career. He reflects on how Bishop Joseph Walker's sermons kept him encouraged when challenges arose during his journey through medical school.

"Bishop helped me to take my spiritual knowledge to another level. I was gifted academically, but when I failed one of my tests at Meharry, I recalled one of Bishop's sermons on sovereignty, explaining how God doesn't have to get permission for what He does and what He allows us to go through. God told me, 'You've gotten this far with your intellect, but it's going to be My supernatural that I put on your natural that's going to allow you to have true success.'"

Turner's first encounter with Bishop Walker was in 2005 when he became the first Mr. Meharry Medical College. After a Wednesday Bible study, he asked Bishop to speak at a seminar he was hosting on campus. From that day forward, Bishop became Turner's mentor.

"We shared an understanding of the importance of mentoring, and that inspired me. I do a lot of mentoring, but I'll never forget the people who paved the way for me. Bishop Walker is extremely busy, but knowing that he still takes time to mentor others helps to keep me grounded and understand that no matter how high you go, you should always reach back and help someone else."

After receiving his medical degree from Meharry Medical College, Turner completed his residency at the University of Mississippi Medical Center, but he did not start his practice right away. "I was not able to fulfill my purpose and destiny as a doctor because I felt as if I couldn't really talk about God and pray with my patients and spend the necessary time with my patients. I also thought I was too young to have my own practice. But Bishop encouraged me, despite older doctors telling me to wait."

Due to faith and his personal expectation, Turner has been able to pass along to his patients the nuggets of wisdom that Bishop deposited into his life. Through it all, he is grateful for the mentorship and role model Bishop continues to be for him.

Faith, hope, prayerfulness. These three words describe the years that Jimmy and Aquanetta Smith lived through the challenges that could have claimed the life of a loving husband and father. Their story is one of trust and divine intervention.

Jimmy and Aquanetta were interrupted by one health challenge after another. While Jimmy was preparing to have half of a cancerous kidney removed, the couple received disturbing news that the cancer had not only damaged the whole kidney but had spread to the other kidney as well. Facing the inevitability of a life on dialysis and a five-year wait before being considered for the transplant list, Jimmy then discovered that he had a blockage in his heart and needed to have a double-bypass before his kidneys could be removed.

In 2005, Jimmy endured two surgeries within a matter of three months, but he recovered, with his wife close by his side. Aquanetta still believed that God was going to turn things around for her husband.

By the grace of God, Jimmy recovered and was diagnosed cancer-free, so he was finally placed on the transplant list to receive a new kidney in 2010. However, the doctors soon found more complications with his heart; so instead of getting a new kidney, he received stents in his legs. Jimmy was added to and removed from the kidney transplant list several times after that. Throughout this journey, the couple declared that they would trust God and continue to praise Him for grace and healing.

On October 4, 2016, their lives would change forever. God was moving behind the scenes. With hopeful hearts and a stack of bills, Jimmy and Aquanetta arrived early to attend the Black Out service at Mount Zion. They knew that something about that night was different. Looking back, they know now that they were right!

While they waited for the service to begin, Aquanetta prepared for a mandatory critical illness presentation that she was less than thrilled to do. Little did she know that her research would lead her to discover thousands of dollars in enrollment benefits for Jimmy. And the next evening, the couple received a call to inform them that a kidney had suddenly become available for Jimmy. Although this had been the third time that they had received this call, something felt right. They remembered that God was faithful to His Word, and they would not believe man's report.

Aquanetta admits to feeling a little discouraged the night before the surgery, but as a loving Father, God directed her to see two church members at the hospital. Alametric and LaShae, who were often seen waving banners and flags during praise and worship each Sunday morning, took time to encourage Aquanetta and to pray with her. They even stood nearby praying when the new kidney arrived by helicopter.

Jimmy received his transplant the next morning, and his surgery was paid for in full. After 11 years of dialysis and health challenges, Jimmy is in recovery and is doing better than the doctors expected he would.

It's a sunny Saturday morning. The neighborhood streets are quiet. Cordney Bledsoe opens the door to greet me but quickly returns to being preoccupied with motherly duties. Omari, Cordney's eightyear-old son, is in his bedroom watching television, while Bailey, age 4, sits on the sofa and plays with her mom's iPad. Yancey, Cordney's husband, has just returned from taking out the trash. Baby Chloé, still in her pajamas, glides across the room in a walker, mesmerized by my flashy mobile device on the coffee table. The 11-month-old then coasts over to the TV stand, tinkers with family photos, and chuckles at the sight of her own reflection smiling back at her in the portrait.

By the sounds of Chloé's coos and laughter, you'd never know that she had been in the battle of her young life just five months earlier. On August 31, 2016, Chloé lay in a hospital bed at Monroe Carell, Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt surrounded by her parents, extended family, a team of doctors, and the Mt. Zion Flock Ministry joined handin-hand to pray for a successful heart surgery.

Days after being born a mere 2 lbs. and 2 oz., Chloé was diagnosed with tetralogy of fallot, a rare congenital heart defect that changes the normal flow of blood through the heart. According to the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute, this disease occurs in about 5 out of every 10,000 babies.

With two older, healthy children, the thought of having a sick child weighed heavily on Cordney. She was in denial and believed the situation would cure itself. Embarrassment was the primary reason few family members and friends knew what was going on. "All my friends were having healthy babies at

the time," said Cordney, a nurse assistant at Vanderbilt Medical Center. "But then my baby was not progressing and gaining weight. I kept wondering, 'How could this happen to my child?' Why, Lord? Why me? What did I do?"

Over the next several months, Chloé's rapid breathing, shortness of breath, and her inability to keep food down persisted. It became clear to Cordney that Chloé needed surgery.

Meanwhile, Yancey and Cordney were struggling financially and looked to Mt. Zion for assistance. The Flock Ministry came to pray for the Bledsoes, paid their electricity bill, and offered to bring them a food box.

Three days prior to the surgery, Chloé was christened at Mt. Zion, where Bishop Joseph Walker, III led the congregation in a prayer for healing. "As a husband, I had to be a rock for my wife," Yancey recalled of the hours before Chloé's surgery. "I put it in God's hands.

Needless to say, the surgery was successful. Glory be to God, Chloé would not be required to wear a pacemaker for the rest of her life, and she would not need blood pressure support. She was even eating better. She was in ICU for only a day, whereas a normal stay for this type of procedure was three to four days. Chloé's cardiologist predicted she would stay in the hospital for weeks. She stayed for only three days. "That was nobody but God!" Cordney proclaimed. "It was a very big test for us."

"God used us. God used Chloé for the good. When He wants to use you, let Him use you," said Yancey.

Today, Chloé is thriving and has to see a cardiologist only once a year. She has not been ill since the surgery, and she celebrated her first birthday in February. Cordney is able to be a stay-at-home mother while Yancey continues to provide for the family as an MTA bus operator.

If you ask Cordney what a difference a year makes, she'd say, "God has really been blessing the Bledsoes."
