Be Prayerful

Before you invite anyone, take it to God. Ask Him to highlight the person in your life who needs this connection. Evangelism begins with spiritual sensitivity. You're not inviting randomly, you're planting seeds in hearts that God is already working on

R



Reach Personally

The most powerful invitations are the ones that feel personal. Go beyond social media shares and make intentional connections. Whether it's your barber, your coworker, your gym buddy, or the parent you see at school pick-up let them know you see them, and you thought of them.

Initiate with Intention

Don't overthink it or wait for the "right" moment, trust that God can use even a simple conversation to spark transformation. A meaningful invitation often begins with showing genuine care and letting the person know you see value in them being part of what God is doing.

N



Normalize the Experience

Help remove the pressure or fear someone might feel about coming to church. For many the idea of showing up can feel intimidating. Let them know Mt. Zion is a place for real people with real stories, not a space where they have to perform or pretend.

Give the Details

Make it easy. People are more likely to come when they know what to expect. Send them the address, share service times, and follow up. so we can connect and celebrate your obedience.
